

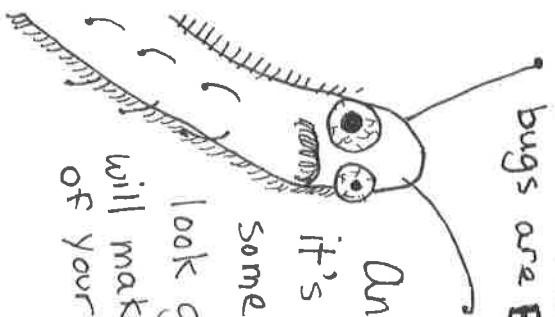

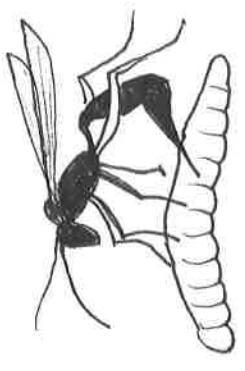


these
